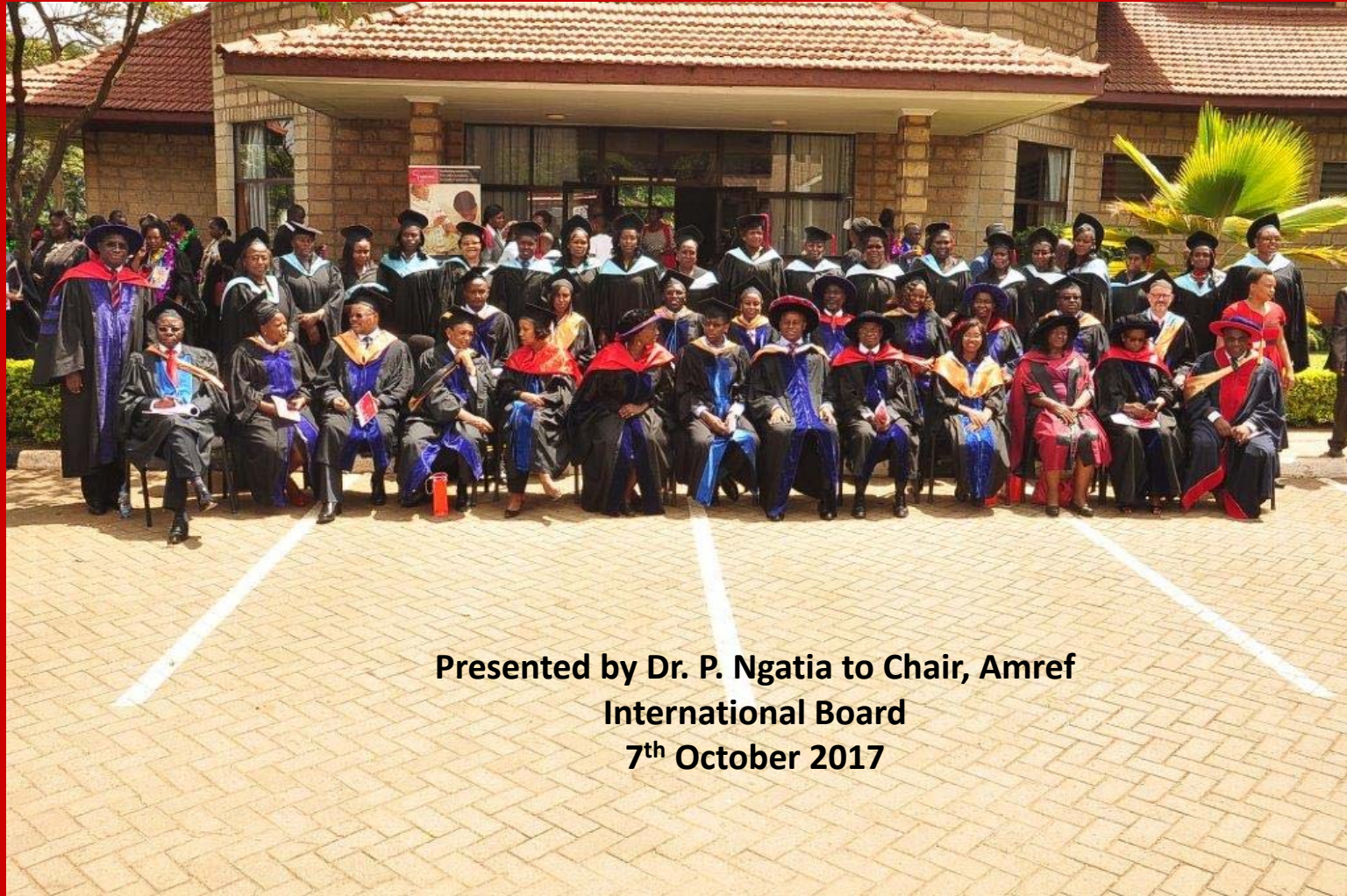

- Undertake high level health systems research for policy formulation and improved practice.

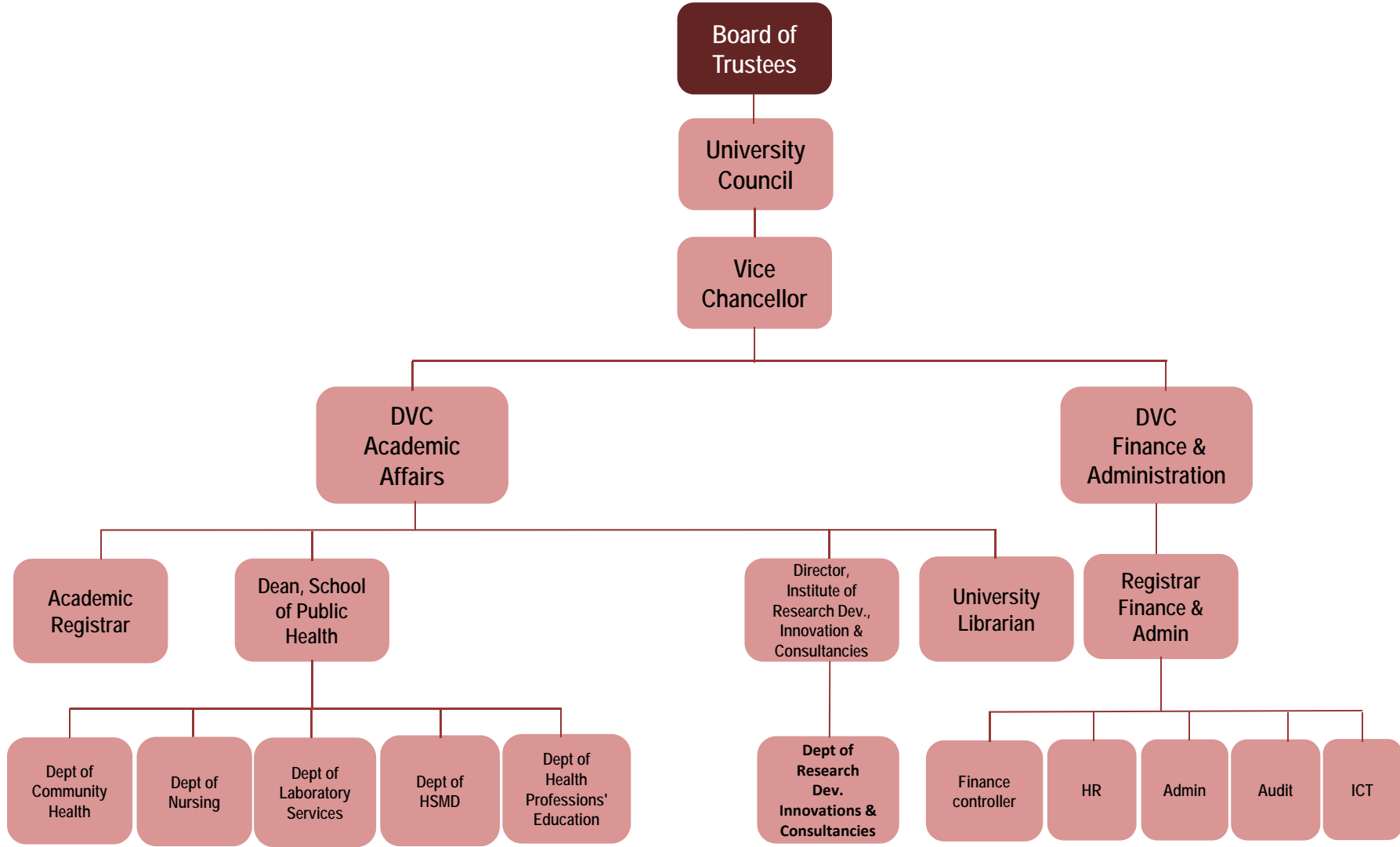


Academic Character of AMIU

 - New and unique curricula

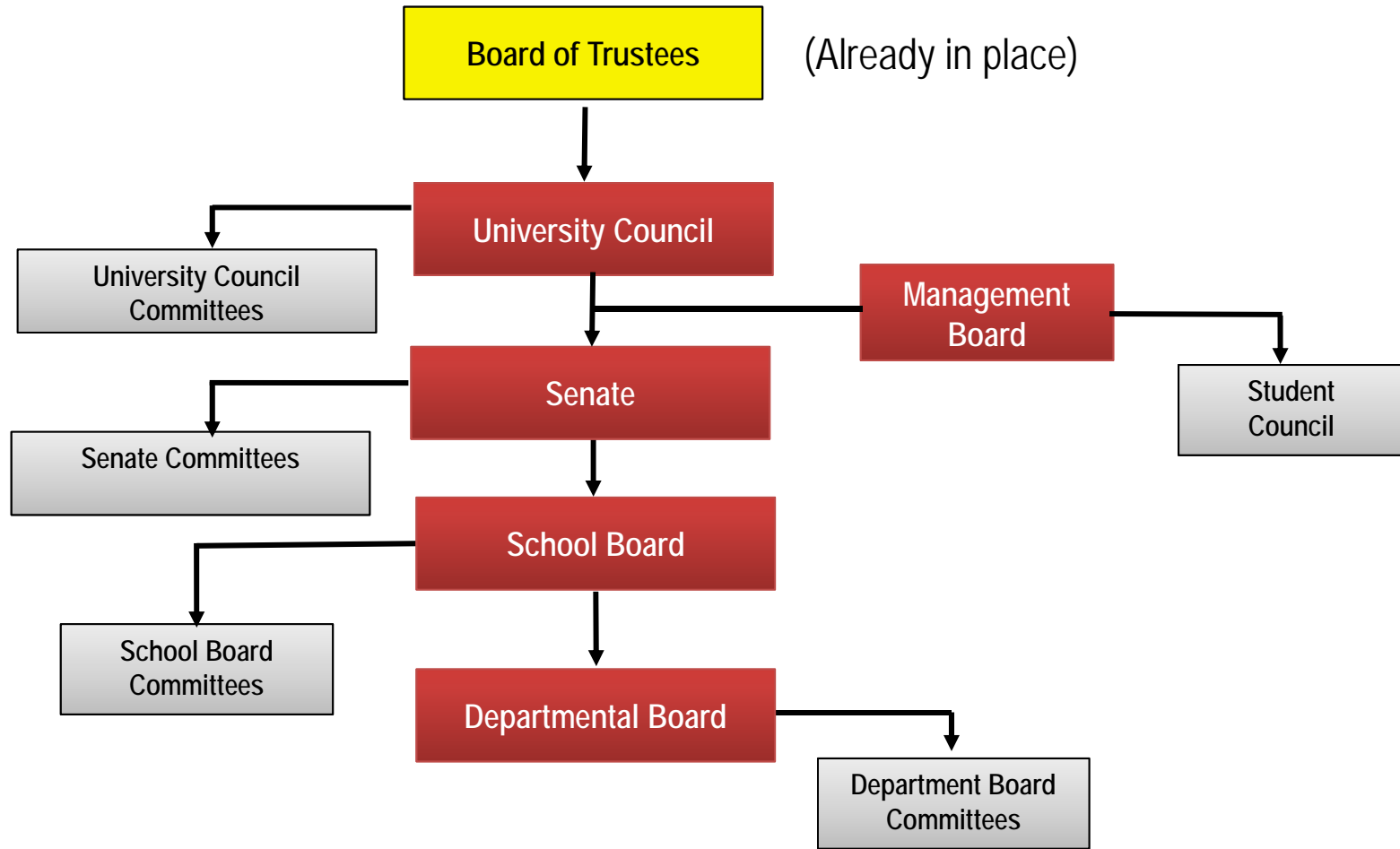


Academic Structure of Amref International University
