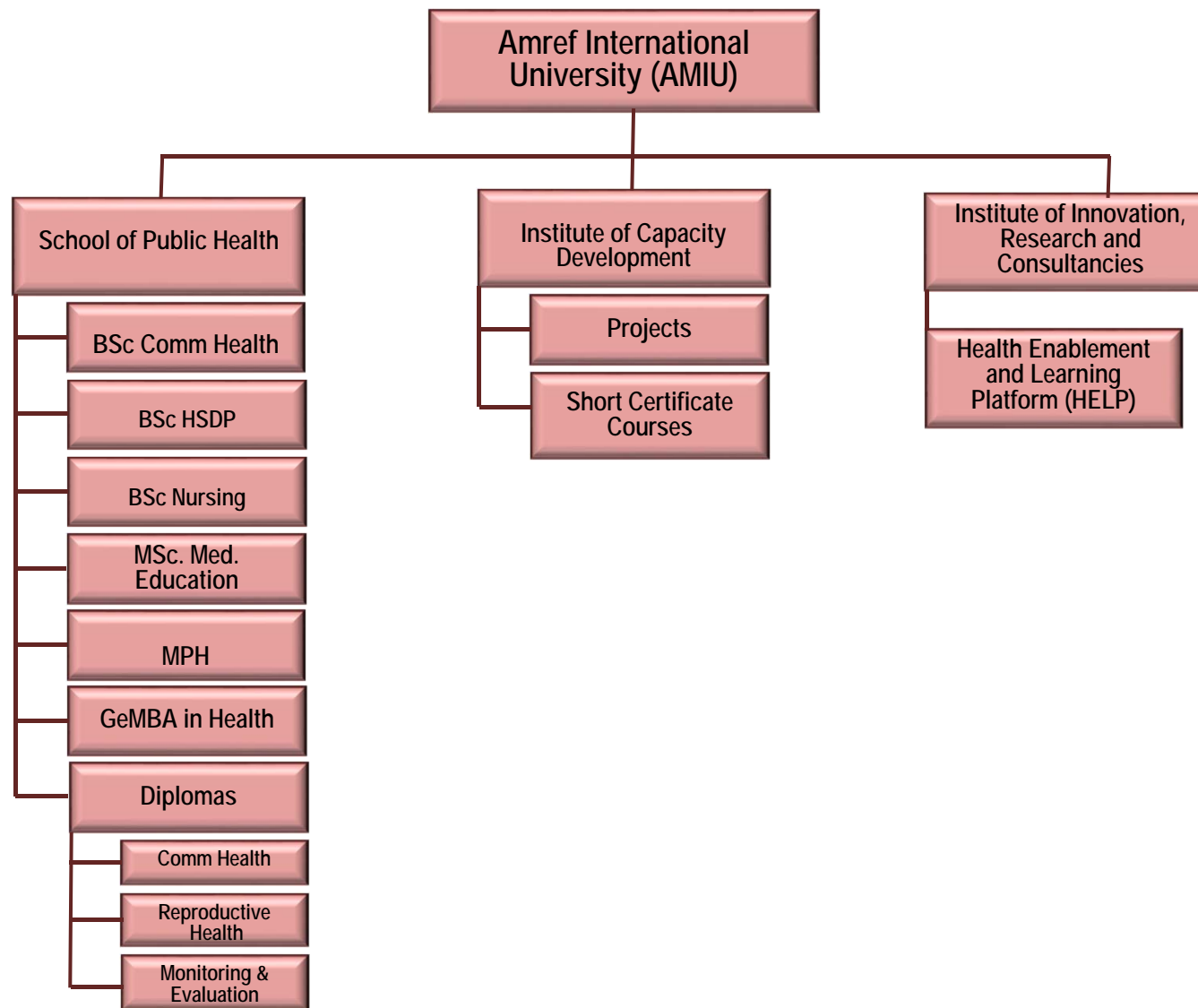


Proposed Name, Vision, Mission and Motto

Inspiring Lasting Change: *Inspirare il cambiamento duraturo*

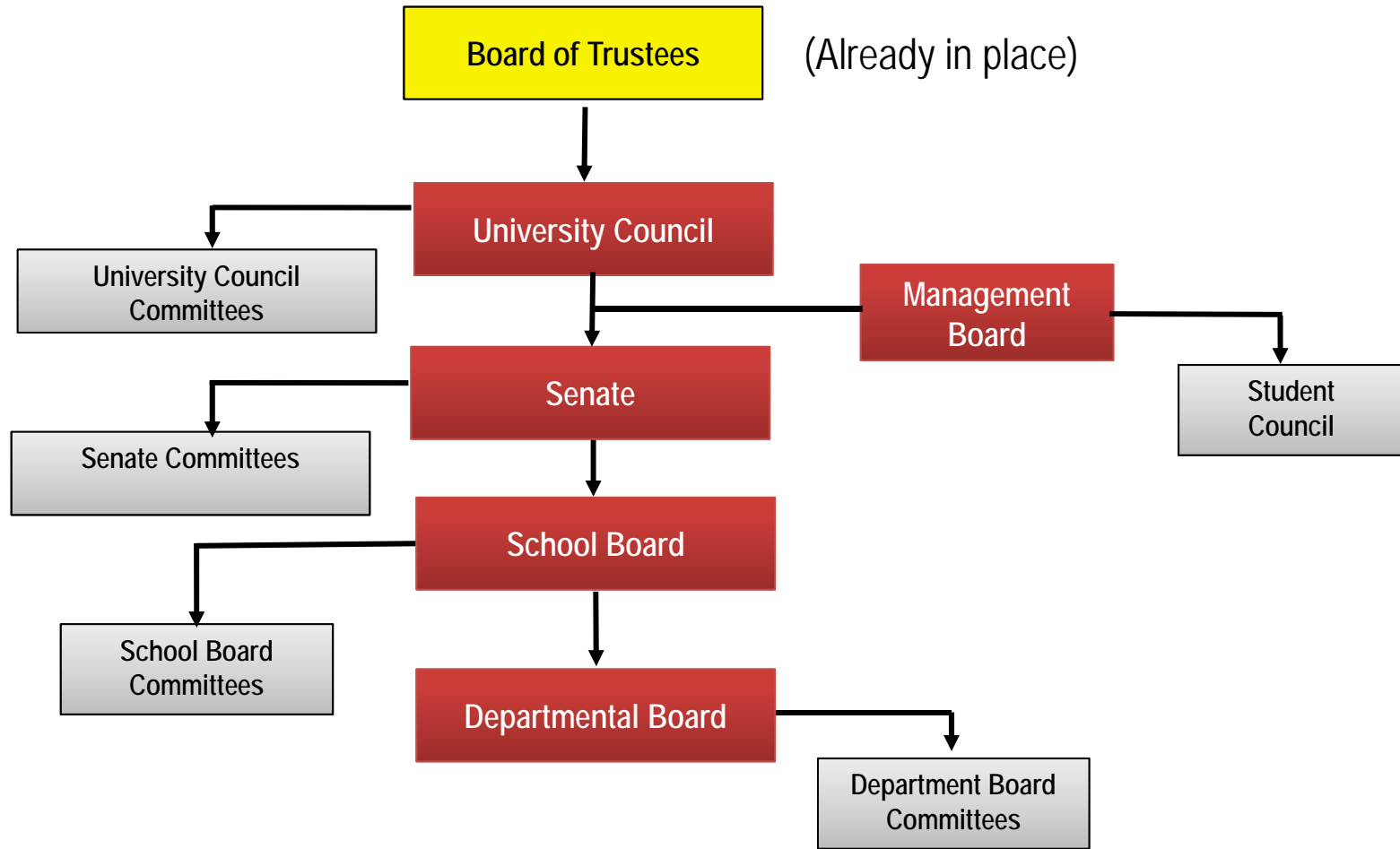


Academic Structure of Amref International University

Makueni Campus

- The Amref International University will have a campus in Makueni County on a site to be identified by the County Government. The application for the land was submitted on 3rd September 2014 and responses received on 29th September 2014 and 29th June 2015, respectively.
- In the last response, the Government of Makueni, through the office of ECM – Lands, Mining and Physical Planning confirmed that the Government was in the process of acquiring for Amref’s purposes, a 50 acre parcel of land just off Makueni – Wote Road, about 15 km from Makindu Town.



Makueni Campus (contd)

- Amref intends to build the “Amref University Makueni Campus” on the designated piece of land. The infrastructure will include:
 - A university campus with classrooms, dormitories, laboratories, and sports and recreation facilities (Phase I).
 - A Trauma/Emergency Hospital (Phase II). This will be a Teaching Hospital specialising in Trauma and Emergency Care. The Amref Flying Doctors (AFD) will manage the hospital.
 - An Airstrip. This will be constructed simultaneously with the hospital. It will enable the AFD to fly in trauma patients from all over the country and especially along Mombasa Road.
