- **Location:** The seat of AMIU is on Langata Road, Nairobi, at the current location of Amref Health Africa HQ and the Amref International Training Centre (AITC).
- **Vision:** To be a leading university of excellence in developing transformational health leaders and practitioners.
- **Mission:** To provide holistic quality education in health sciences and related disciplines for the well-being of the society.
- **Motto:** Inspiring Lasting Change: *Inicere perpetuam mutationem*



Letter of Interim Authority (LIA)

- The University is fully accredited through a Letter of Interim Authority granted on 1st August 2017.
- The University is now a body corporate with authority and powers to award degrees and diplomas.
- AMIU has the power to:
 - Set-up governing body (Board), e.g., BOT, Council;
 - Develop the necessary physical facilities;
 - Advertise, admit and teach students;
 - Recruit academic/administration staff.
- AMIU first Strategic Plan has been developed.

- Objective 6:** To develop the capacity of students to be independent critical thinkers for the well-being of the society.

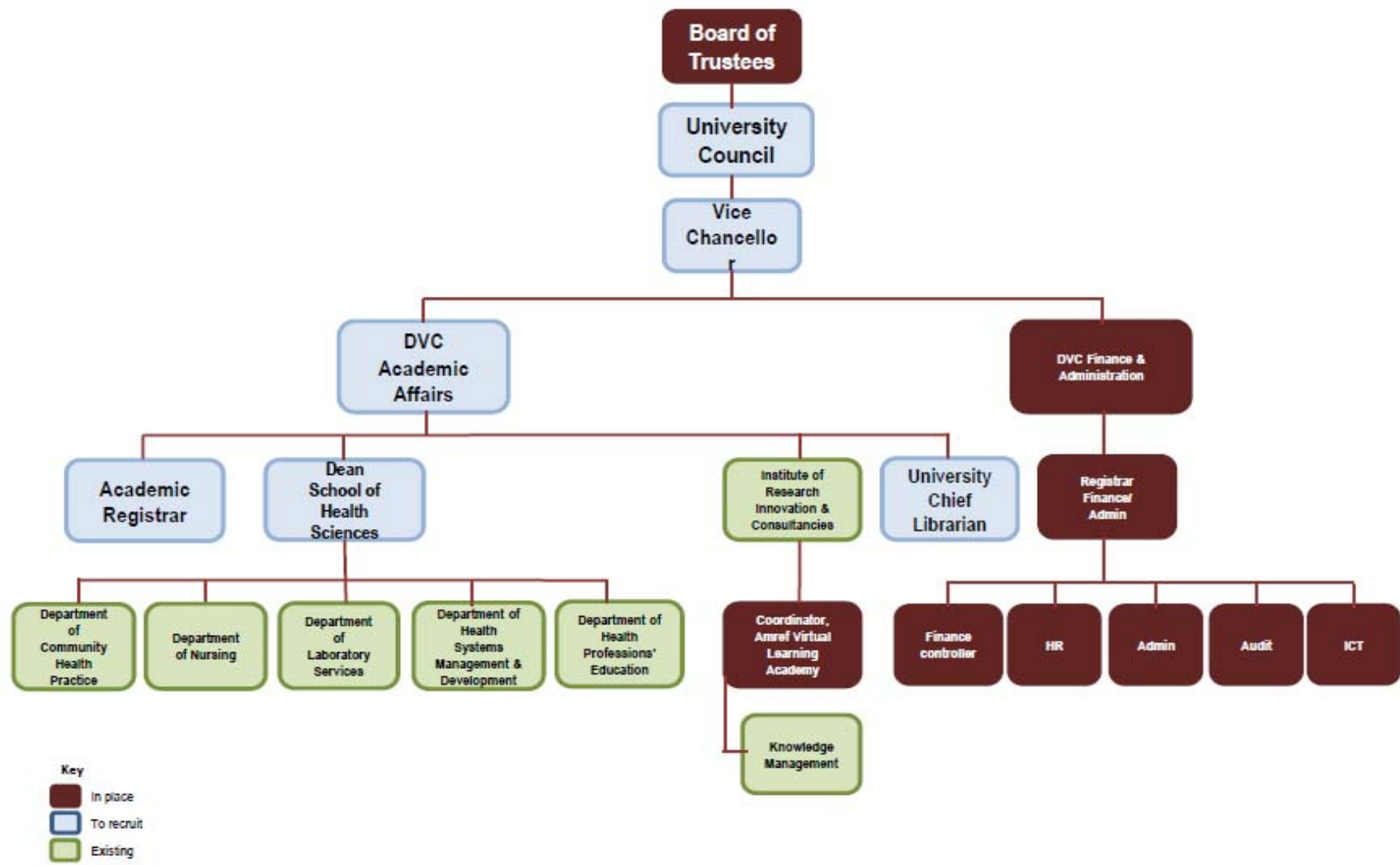


Uniqueness of AMIU

- Provision of extensive practice-based learning through community and public health projects of Amref Health Africa.

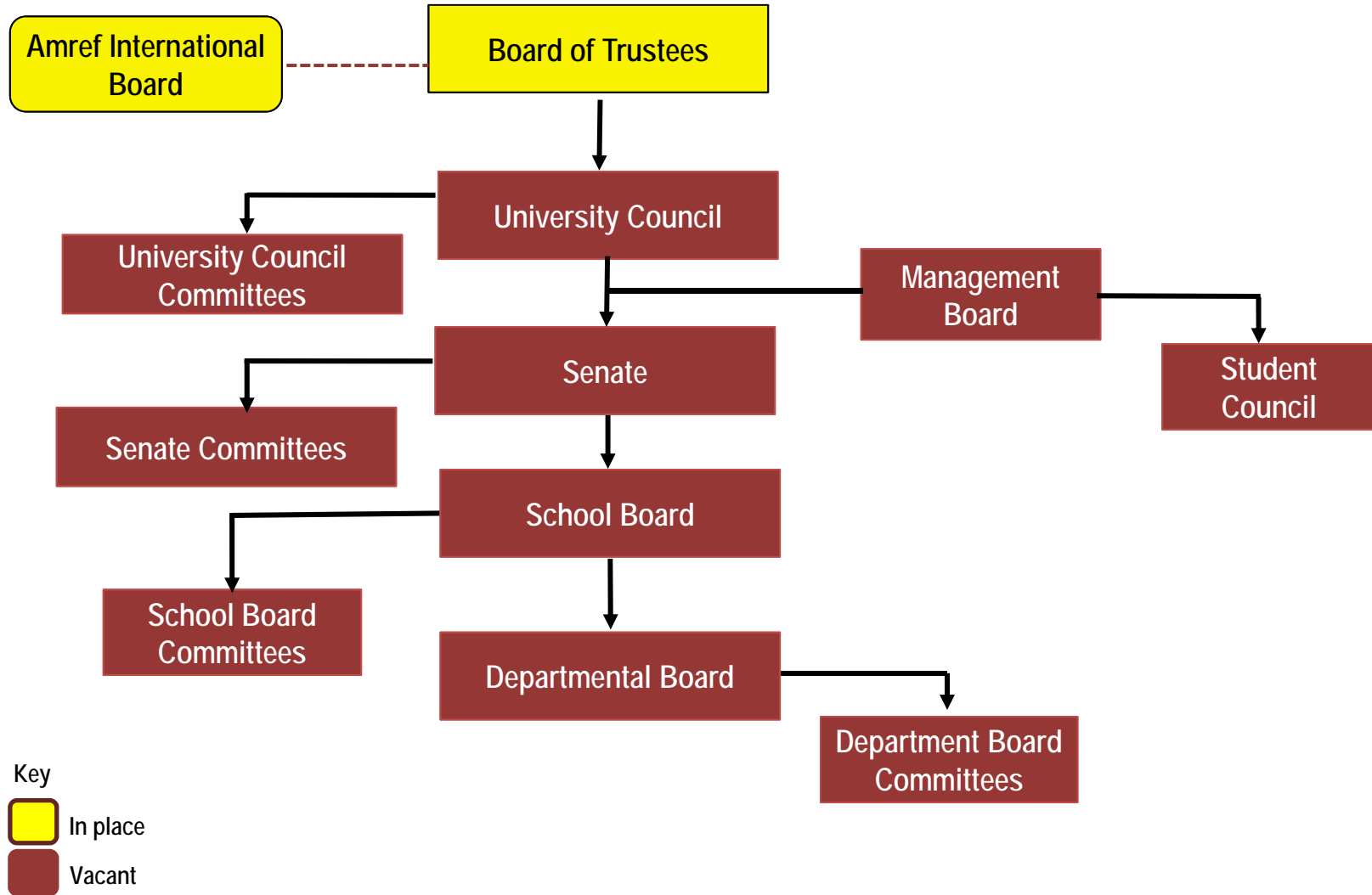


Academic Structure of Amref International University

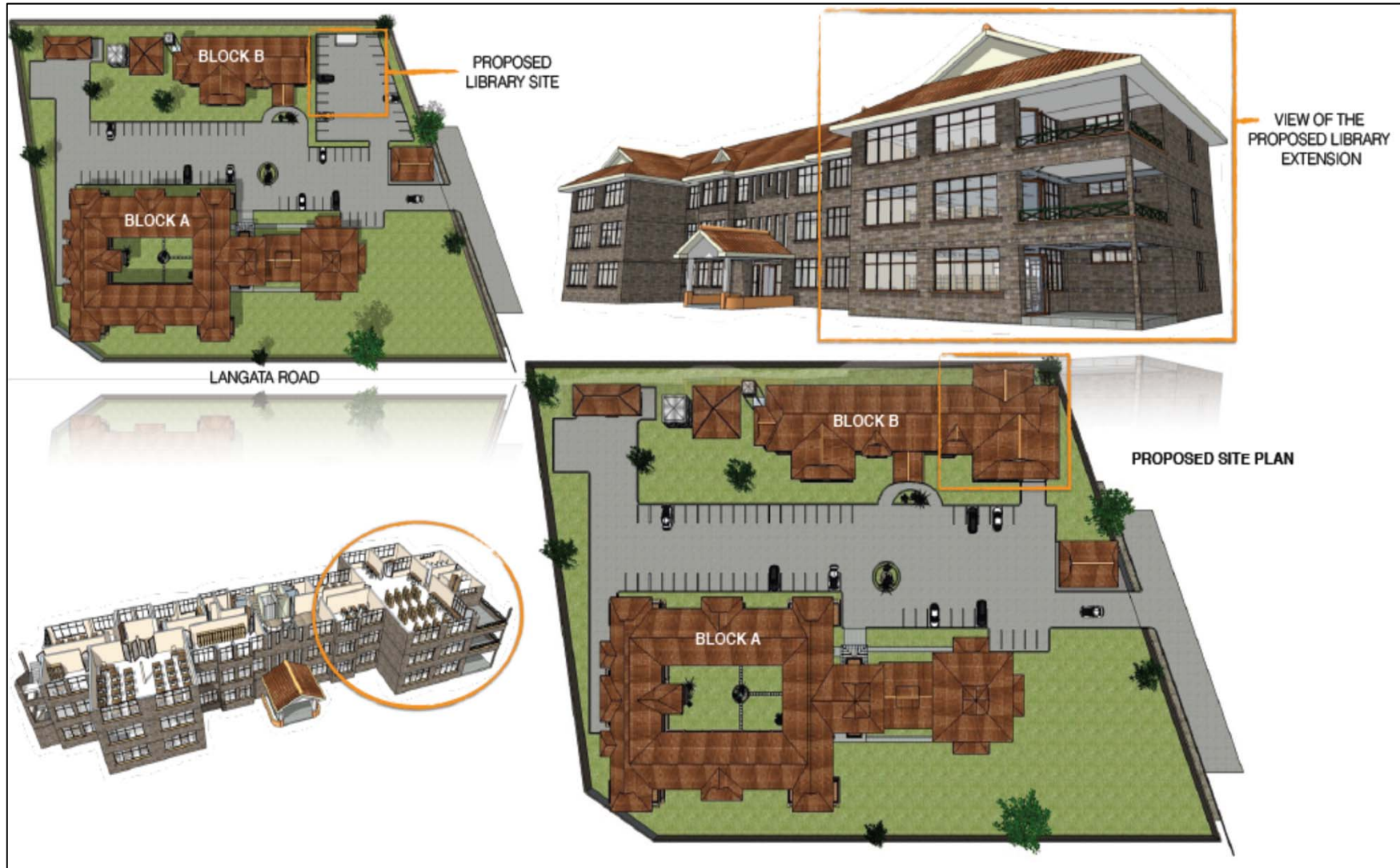

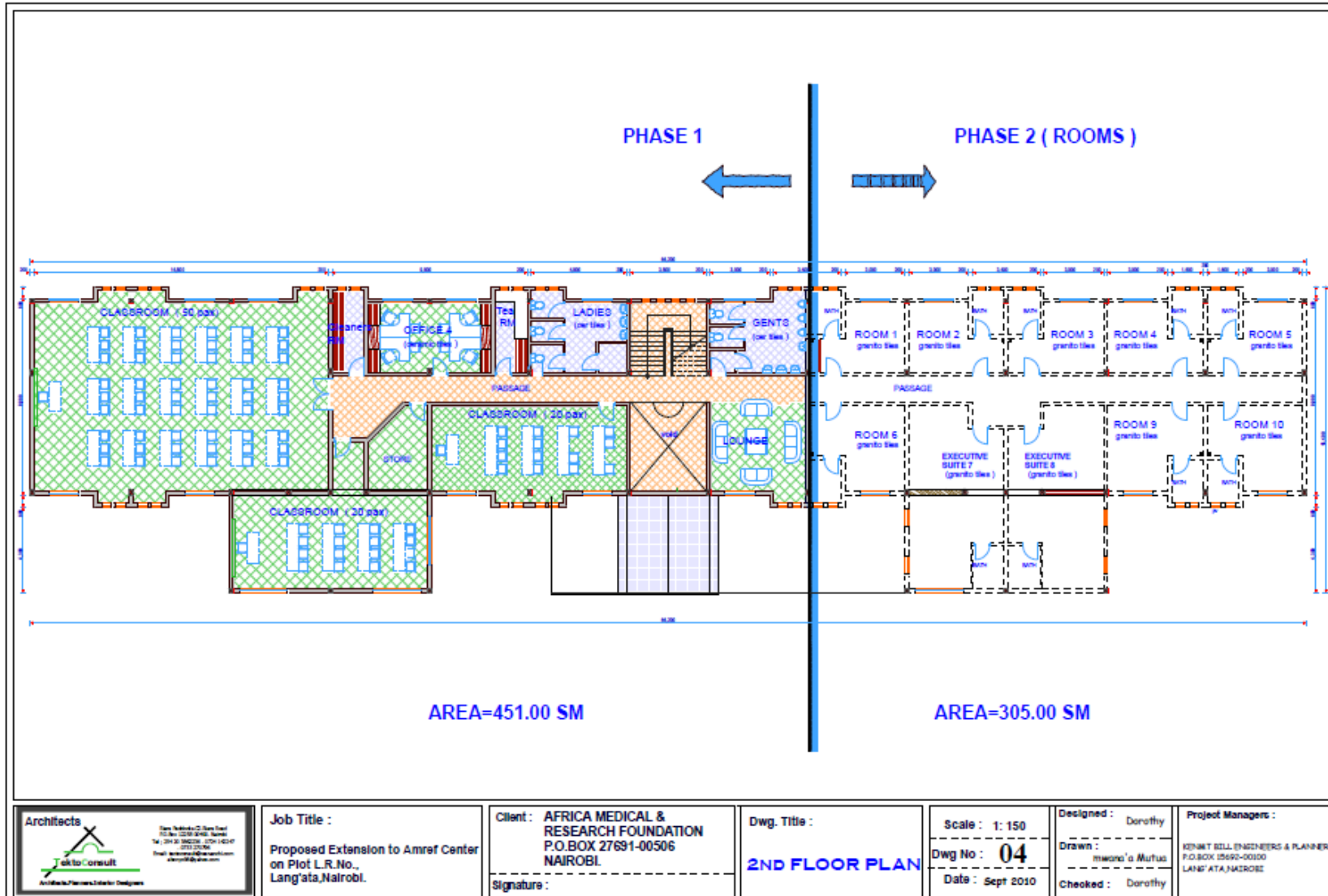


Proposed Development Infrastructure A: Proposed Library Extension

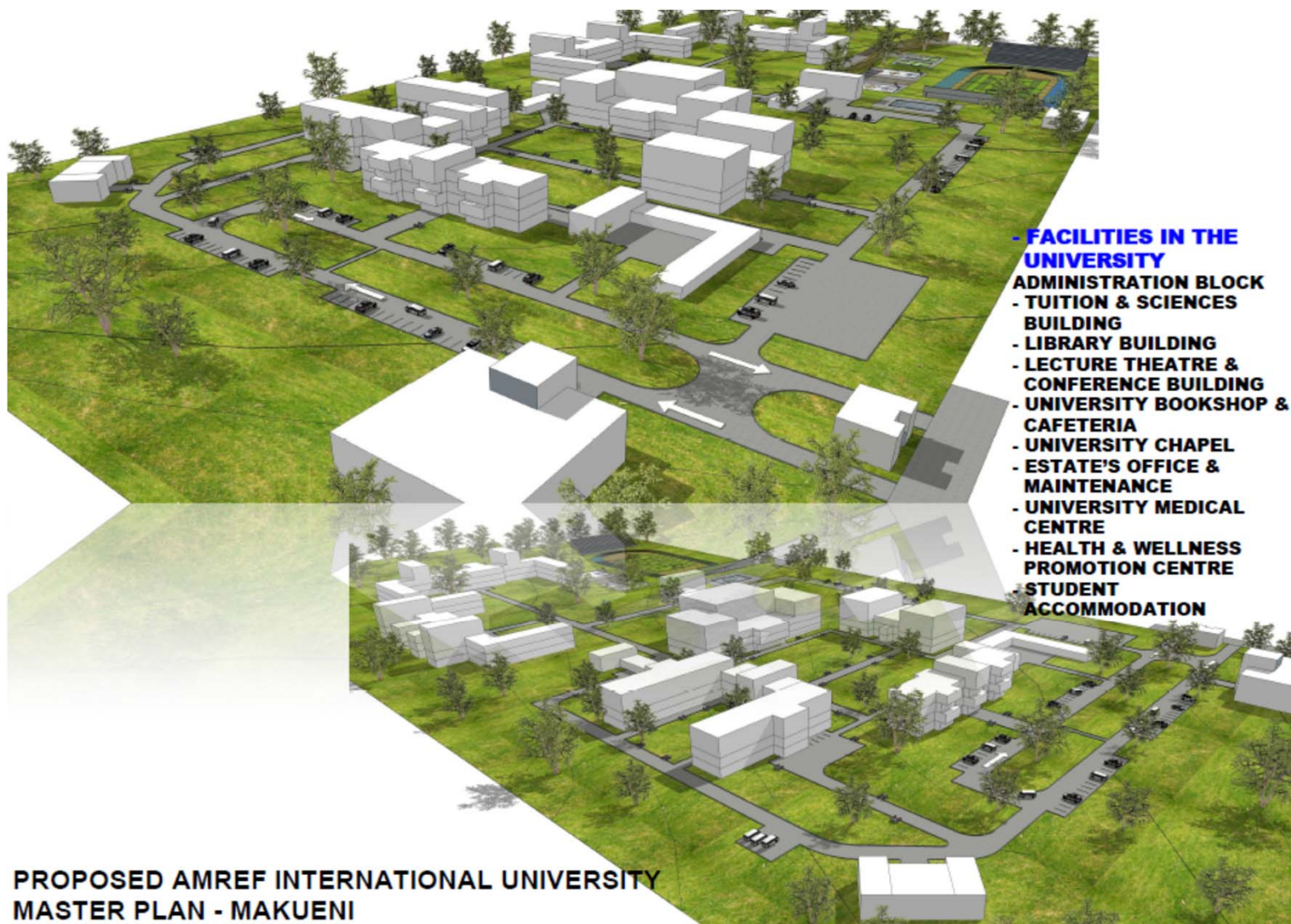

C: Proposed Future Main Campus of AMIU



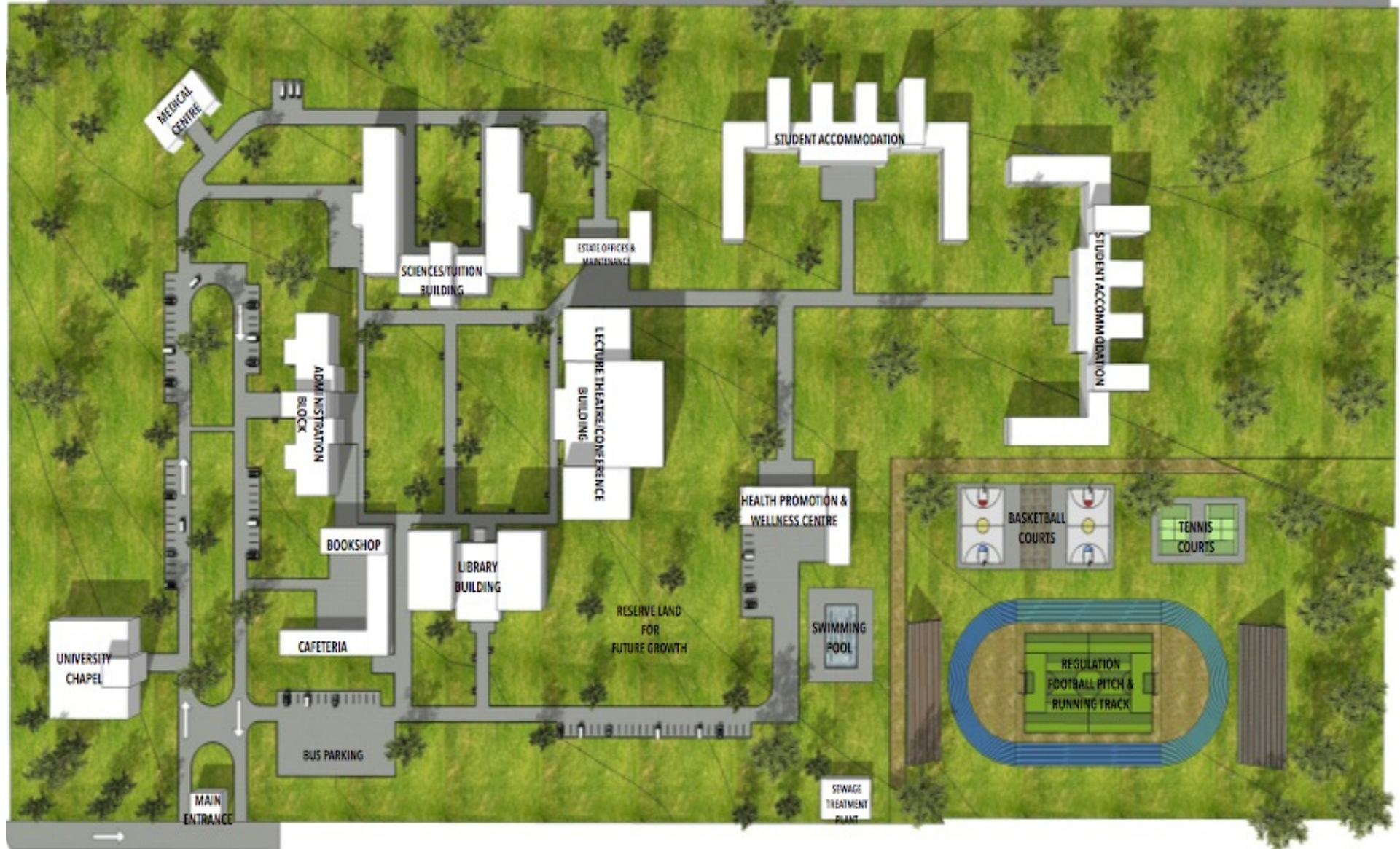
