solemnly swear, before the almighty God, in the presence of this assembly, to observe the Nurses Code of Ethics and Conduct.

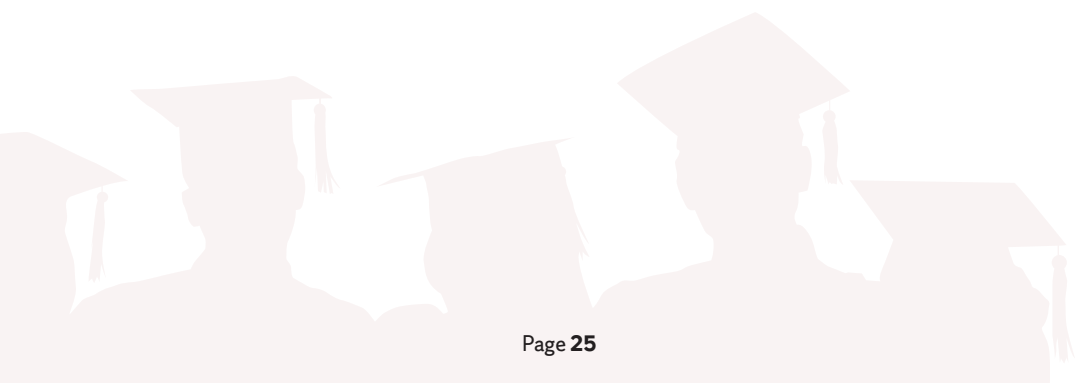
I will faithfully practice the esteemed profession of nursing in accordance with the laid down laws and regulations.
